

## Red wine

### **Cabernet Sauvignon, Trivento Tribu, 2009 Argentina.**

Soft and concentrated with juicy blackcurrant fruit and a lovely leafy character.  
175ml glass: 3.25 250ml glass: 4.65 Bottle: 13.50

### **Merlot, Norte Chico, 2009 Chile.**

Smooth and rounded, with a delicious damson fruit note, made from grapes picked in the Central Valley in Chile. A fine, silky red with a firm fruit backbone. 175ml glass: 3.35 250ml glass: 4.75 Bottle: 14.00

### **Tempranillo, Castillo de Montblanc, 2007 Concha de Barbera, Spain.**

Medium bodied with aromatic red fruits and some savoury notes. Sweet raspberry and strawberry fruit define the creamy, yet crisp, balanced palate. 175ml glass: 3.65 250ml glass: 5.20 Bottle: 15.50

### **DOC Rioja Livor, Viña Ijalba, 2008 Spain. [V]**

A popular Rioja due to the beguiling raspberry jam character which has no rough edges. Velvety smooth from start to finish. 175ml glass: 3.95 250ml glass: 5.65 Bottle: 16.25

### **Pinot Noir "Explorer" Concha Y Toro, 2009 Chile.**

Light to medium bodied. Earthy, with lovely piercing strawberry fruit. 175ml glass: 4.20 250ml glass: 5.95 Bottle: 17.25

### **Shiraz/Cabernet/Grenache, Stickleback, 2008 Australia.**

Soft and spicy. Blackcurrants and summer berries with hints of eucalyptus and a smooth round palate. 175ml glass: 4.25 250ml glass: 6.10 Bottle: 18.00

### **Carmenère Reserva, De Gras, 2008 Chile.**

Carmenère is planted only in Chile and until recently was mistaken for Merlot, but as this example shows it is more interesting than most Merlots, with the soft black fruit flavours being complemented by a dash of pepper and spice. 19.95

### **Zinfandel, Barra Estate, 2005 USA. [V]**

Full-bodied red with super-ripe cassis fruits, sprinkled with cinnamon and pepper. 21.50

### **Allegrini Valpolicella, 2008 Italy.**

Light to medium bodied, with aromas of sweet cherries and violet. The palate shows impressive depth with exuberant, luscious fruit and hints of spice leading to a pleasant, supple finish. 22.25

### **Pinot Noir, Meinklang, 2007 Austria. [V]**

This excellent wine shows ripe, red cherry fruits defining the palate and are neatly intertwined with soft tannins. Very seductive indeed. Made biodynamically. 23.00

### **Côte du Rhône "Les Antimagnes" Domaine des Escaravailles, 2008 France.**

Deep purple in colour with powerful aromas of lush red fruit. Deeply concentrated with great opulence and depth. Excellent balance with fully integrated, ripe tannins. 24.95

### **Malbec, Trivento Golden Reserva, 2006 Argentina.**

Big, muscular and complex. Full red fruit palate with spicy hints of cinnamon, pepper and chocolate. 29.75

### **DO Priorat FA206, Mas Igneus, 2005 Spain. [V]**

Lush, generous black fruits with additional fennel and tobacco qualities. Ripe, sweet, and utterly delicious. 33.00

### **Rioja, Marqués de Murrieta, 2003 Spain.**

Complex layers of sweet and savoury fruit, vanilla and spice. Full, fresh and vibrant. 39.50

### **Santenay, Pinot Noir, Philippe Colin, 2005 France.**

Silky-textured, intense blueberry fruit, classic Burgundian earthiness with an amazing depth of flavour. 49.75

### **Domaine de Villeneuve Châteauneuf "Les Vieilles Vignes", 2004 France.**

Dense and spicy with concentrated redcurrant and raspberry fruit, violets and liquorice. 57.50

### **Mitolo "Serpico" Cabernet Sauvignon, 2003 McLaren Vale, Australia.**

Huge, dark and refined. Cedary spice, Christmas pudding and a hint of coffee bean with rich savoury tannins. Seamless integration of oak, tannin and fruit. 62.00

## Rosé wine

### **Castillo de Mont Blanc Trapat Rosat, 2008 Spain.**

Fantastic dry rosé, full flavoured with hints of stonefruit and raspberry. The perfect summer wine. 175ml glass: 3.65 250ml glass: 5.25 Bottle: 15.25

### **Pinot Noir Rosé, J Wolf, 2007 Germany.**

Pale salmon pink in colour, with hints of rhubarb and raspberry, a rich creamy texture and a splash of strawberry. 23.50

## sparkling wine and champagne

### **Castillo de Montblanc Brut Cava, Spain.**

Subtle and delicate aromas with a hint of toastiness. Crisp, clear and elegant 125ml glass: 3.75 Bottle: 21.50

### **Meinklang Prosa Pinot Noir Rosé, Austria. [V]**

Made uniquely from Pinot Noir, this quality frizzante has a refreshing palate with generous quantities of red summer berry fruits and biscuity notes. Made biodynamically. 23.95

### **Devaux Grande Réserve Brut Champagne, France.**

A complex champagne with ripe apricot and citrus fruit, a hint of spicy toastiness and a clean refreshing finish. The Pinot Noir grape gives power and body, while the Chardonnay adds fruit and elegance. 47.50

### **Roederer Estate Quartet NV, Anderson Valley, California.**

This wine has an initial citrus freshness that seamlessly flows into a mid-palate of lemon cream biscuits underpinned by hints of raspberry, with a long and dry finish. 51.00

### **Bollinger Special Cuvée Brut NV, Champagne.**

Bollinger Special Cuvée is one of the fullest champagnes with an intensely rich character of freshly baked bread alongside citrus and baked apple fruit. 77.50

<b>Colombard/Ugni Blanc, Domaine de Millet, 2008 France.</b> An eminently quaffable and refreshing Gascogne white. Green apples and pear skin on the nose lead to surprisingly rich mid-palate fruit and tangy fresh acidity on the finish. 175ml glass: 3.75 250ml glass: 5.35 Bottle: 15.75	
<b>Rioja, Sonsierra Viura, 2009 Spain.</b> Fresh, youthful white Rioja at its best. Dry and clean with mouthwatering citrus and light floral notes. Delicate, yet displaying a fairly full texture and refreshing finish. 175ml glass: 4.10 250ml glass: 5.85 Bottle: 17.25	
<b>Pinot Grigio, Alpha Zeta, 2009 Italy.</b> [V] This Pinot Grigio is slightly fuller than most as the grapes are left on the vine for an extra 2-3 weeks. Zesty and dry with savoury fruit characters. 175ml glass: 4.35 250ml glass: 6.25 Bottle: 18.25	
<b>Fiano Greco, A-Mano, 2009 Italy.</b> [V] A lovely, perfumed white from the south of Italy with enticing stone-fruit aroma, a ripe full palate and great structure. 175ml glass: 4.70 250ml glass: 6.75 Bottle: 19.50	
<b>Grüner Veltliner, Meinklang, 2008 Austria.</b> [V] This is a real treat of a white, with a unique personality. Refreshingly dry with not so much of a hint of oak but with lots of minerally, zesty fruits instead. Made biodynamically. 19.75	
<b>Chardonnay, Clos Montblanc, 2008 Conca de Barbera, Spain.</b> Lots of creamy spicy oak, from fermentation in French barrels. Rich tropical fruit, refreshing citrus flavours, and great persistence. 22.50	
<b>Pinot Noir, Blanc de Noir, Richmond Plains, 2008 New Zealand.</b> [V] A "white" wine made from red grapes? It's an inviting pale salmon pink colour with deliciously light raspberry and rhubarb flavours, and a super-fresh finish. 23.95	
<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Iona, 2009 South Africa.</b> South Africa's best Sauvignon Blanc. Delicate and refreshing with lots of minerality, exceptional richness with layers of pure fruit and soothing herbaceous notes. 25.00	
<b>Riesling, Pirie South, 2006 Tasmania, Australia.</b> Riesling made by Dr. Andrew Pirie, the pioneer of winemaking in Tasmania. Medium dry, with citrus and mineral elements and a crisp, rounded, lemony finish. 25.75	
<b>Albariño, Lagar de Cervera, 2008 Spain.</b> Aromatic, with peaches, apricot, melon and citrus on the palate. 30.50	
<b>Sancerre, Paul Doucet et fils, 2008 France.</b> Racy, mineral, classically French Sauvignon Blanc with good weight and hints of green apple and melon. 32.00	
<b>Chablis Premier Cru, Côte de Lechet, 2004 France.</b> Firm, full and chalky with nice ripe fruit and subtle toasty oak. Beautifully balanced. 45.00
